ASCLEPIOS AWARD Mark Awad, MD, PhD

Associate Professor, Medicine, Harvard Medical School Medical Oncologist, Medical Oncology, Dana-Farber Institute

Honoring pioneers in research in the fight to end lung cancer, exemplifying the spirit of Asclepios, Greek god of medicine and healing.

Dr. Mark Awad is an associate professor of medicine at Harvard Medical School and clinical director of the Lowe Center for Thoracic Oncology at the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute. He received his undergraduate degree from Harvard University and his MD and PhD degrees from the Johns Hopkins School of Medicine. He completed his residency and chief residency at Massachusetts General Hospital, and his medical oncology fellowship at the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute before joining the Dana-Farber faculty in 2014. His translational research focus is on identifying biomarkers of response and resistance to targeted therapies and immunotherapies in lung cancer. He is the principal investigator of several clinical trials for patients with thoracic malignancies and collaborates closely with laboratory-based investigators. His research has been published in journals such as the New England Journal of Medicine, the Journal of Clinical Oncology, Cancer Immunology Research, and the Journal of Thoracic Oncology. He is a recipient of the 2015 Young Investigator Award from the American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO), the 2015 Young Investigator Award from the International Association for the Society of Lung Cancer (IASLC), the 2017 Career Development Award from Conquer Cancer Foundation of ASCO, and the 2018 ALK Positive/LUNGevity Transformational Research Award.

Dr. Awad is currently the principal investigator for two ongoing clinical trials supported by Addario Lung Cancer Medical Institute: ALCMI-011 (Spacewalk; ALK+), and ALCMI-016 (Spark; Kras).



### WIND BENEATH MY WINGS CAREGIVER AWARD

### Sven de Jong, husband of Elizabeth de Jong



### "Rising to the occasion." "Moving mountains." "First line of defense."

These are words used by family and friends to describe caregiver Sven de Jong. Sven was the cherished husband of Elizabeth de Jong, who was diagnosed in 2016 with stage 4 ALK+ non-small cell lung cancer. Sadly, Elizabeth passed away earlier this year.

No one knew better than Elizabeth what an extraordinary caregiver he was because right after she was diagnosed she nominated him. At the time she said how grateful she felt to have him as her partner. When she shared how

worried she was with Sven, he always responded with "you don't need to worry. That's my job. Your job is to fight cancer and stay as healthy as you can."

More than anything, Sven wanted Elizabeth to live life to the fullest and for them to keep making memories together for as long as they could. Sven took on the herculean task of researching the latest treatment advancements. He fostered relationships with Elizabeth's care team. He stayed by her side and slept at the hospital. He was also a fierce advocate, refusing to take no for an answer. "When insurance wouldn't approve coverage for an increased medication dosage, Sven appealed multiple times, advocating for what Elizabeth needed to keep living," says friend Jen Cosgrove. His tenacity led to success. Her quarterly tests made her anxious. Sven helped her soldier on. He wanted her to have something to look forward to, so he would book a trip to a secret location. They both loved to travel.

The last year of her life was especially difficult. After a long hospital stay, Sven wanted her to breathe fresh air and have a change of scenery. He warmed blankets in the dryer and wrapped Elizabeth in a cocoon on their condo's terrace. "They were truly a dynamic duo," says friend Colleen Ziegler.

### A Legacy of Advocacy

After the diagnosis, the couple became advocates. Libby's Lungs raised \$65,000 to support Women's Lung Cancer Research at Hillman Cancer Center where Elizabeth received care. They also advocated on Capitol Hill for funding, fought stigma, and helped to plan and attended multiple GO2 for Lung Cancer Voices Summits.

When Elizabeth nominated Sven, she wrote, "I may worry about many things, but not about whether research will keep moving forward and we will find a cure. I know that Sven is the wind beneath the wings for the entire lung cancer community." Libby's Lungs continues today with Sven sharing Elizabeth's story and telling government leaders that it is unacceptable that 70,000+ women die every year from this disease.

As Ellen de Jong, Sven's sister-in-law, says, "Sven is the caregiver of Elizabeth's legacy to future individuals with lung cancer. He will always be the wind beneath Elizabeth's wings, and he is now the wind beneath a fleet of movers, shakers, and researchers focused on treatment, prevention, and advancement. Elizabeth would expect nothing less from her husband, and he has never disappointed."

In the realm of healthcare advocacy, there are individuals who rise above the ordinary and stand as inspiring leaders and beacons of hope for their unwavering commitment to making a difference. Bonnie J. Addario is undeniably one such luminary. With a resolute spirit, boundless compassion and energy, she has dedicated her life to championing the cause of those living with lung cancer, ensuring that their voices are heard, their rights are upheld, and their access to innovative treatments is facilitated.

### A Pioneer Empowering People with Lung Cancer

Bonnie was on the brink of retirement from a high-powered corporate career when she heard the words, "you have lung cancer." Diagnosed with stage 3b lung cancer, she became frustrated by the lack of information to help patients and their families. After undergoing chemotherapy, radiation, and a complicated, risky surgery, Bonnie not only survived, but came away with a new-found mission in life. With unwavering determination, she embarked on a second career that initiated a paradigm shift in lung cancer care. Retirement would have to wait.

### The Three Pillars of Bonnie's Legacy: Organizations that Shape the Future

Bonnie's impact extends beyond her personal journey and advocacy efforts. Her vision and determination have given birth to three remarkable and transformative non-profit organizations: the Bonnie J. Addario Lung Cancer Foundation, Addario Lung Cancer Medical Institute (ALCMI), and GO2 for Lung Cancer. Each of these organizations plays a pivotal role in advancing the cause of lung cancer patients and reshaping the landscape of lung cancer care.


